COMMEMORATION OF THE 2022 INTEGRATED PUBLIC SERVICE MONTH (IPSM)

CIRCULAR NO. 43 of 2022

- 1.1. This circular contains information on the 2022 annual Integrated Public Service Month (IPSM) celebration that will be held from 29 August -02 October 2022 across the public service.
- 1.2. The IPSM is a Service Delivery Improvement Mechanism that annually reflects on the work of the Public Service and celebrates the unwavering commitment of public servants throughout the country.
- 1.3. The IPSM is celebrated during the month of September, and 2022 will focus on affirming government's commitment to upholding the values and principles of public administration enshrined in Section 195 of the Constitution, as well as the constitutional responsibility of the State as articulated in the Bill of Rights to deliver services to the citizenry.
- 1.4. Noting that the year 2022 marks the 25th anniversary of the Batho Pele White Paper as a framework for the transformation of public service delivery, the theme of the 2022 Public Service Month is: "Batho Pele Revitalisation-walking the talk".

- 1.5. The theme for the 2022 IPSM is a clarion call to the country's public servants to dedicate themselves and translate the Batho Pele Revitalisation Strategy into tangible results for citizens.
- 1.6. The DPSA is responsible for providing the concept document that focuses the celebration as well as coordinate MPSA national activities (public service wide activities). The concept document provides a blueprint and guidelines for the planning and implementation of the activities a national and provincial spheres.
- 1.7. In order to strengthen alignment and integrated planning, the national, provincial and local sphere stakeholders are requested to coordinate and share their implementation reports for the PSM celebrations. You are requested to submit the departmental implementation reports for the celebration of the APSD and IPSM by 30 November 2022.
- 1.8. Your Department/Province is requested to nominate representatives comprising of senior managers, youth and frontline officials, to participate and support the IPSM celebrations. Further, logistics in this regard will be forwarded to the nominated officials.
