KZN CIRCULAR NO 57 OF 2022

DESIGNATED DAYS FOR SCHOOL VISITS: 2022 ROYAL SHOW- 27 MAY TO 05 JUNE 2022

- 1. The Royal Agricultural Society is hosting the Annual Royal Show as from 27 May to 05 June 2022.
- 2. All Principals of schools are requested to note the following information with regards to the 2022 Royal Show:
 - 2.1 The formal school groups will only receive the discounted rate on Wednesday, 01 and Thursday, 02 June 2022;
 - 2.2 On these days (01 and 02 June 2022), all learners (<u>in school uniform</u>), will receive a discounted rate of R45.00 per learner and one educator for every 20 learners will be permitted entry free of charge. Additional educators will pay R75.00 each;
 - 2.3 In the interest of safety; for every 9 learners under the age of 10, there must be at least one educator / supervisor to accompany them. Access to the cattle arena and the funfair will be denied if this minimal condition is not met.
 - 2.4 All learners under the age of 12 must wear some form of arm or neck band which incorporates their
 - School's name, parent's name, address and telephone number, which will be used to assist the learners who get lost.



DESIGNATED DAYS FOR SCHOOL VISITS: 2020 ROYAL SHOW- 22 MAY TO 31 MAY 2020

- 2.5 All buses are requested to park in the designated area within the grounds of Townhill Hospital. The grounds will be accessed via Townbush Road. Bus parking is free.
- 2.6 The Royal Show is South Africa's largest commercial and agricultural exhibition which is coupled with an entertainment component. A visit to the Royal show is always stimulating and educational. In order for leaners to achieve maximum benefit from the outing, it is suggested that Principals and Teachers set certain projects for the day.
- 2.7 Should any school wish to make a payment in advance, Principals may send an email to accounts@royalshow.co.za indicating the number of learners and educators that will be visiting the Royal Show, a proforma invoice will be forwarded to the school for payment. Proof of payment and a copy of the invoice will have to be handed to gate control personnel at Townhill Hospital to gain entry into the Showgrounds.
- 2.8 It must be noted that no alcohol or any item deemed (at the sole discretion of the Royal Show Security) to be hazardous will be admitted into the grounds. This includes, amongst others, knives, laser-lights, BB guns, sjamboks and firecrackers.
- 3. The schools must still comply with the policy on Excursions while undertaking the trips to the Royal Show Grounds and necessary approval must be sought from the Department.
- 4. Measures are to be provided for security of all learners and teachers who will undertake the trip.
