Day 3: consisted of the Open Section for Solos and Small Ensembles and the Secondary 'A' Choirs categories, and the winners included learners from Empangeni High School, Mabayana Secondary School, Ekwazini High School, and Zama High School, from KwaZulu-Natal.

Day 4: consisted of the Open Section and Secondary 'A' Choirs categories, and the winners included learners from Umlazi High School, Aquadene Secondary School, Kwapata Secondary School, Empangeni High School, Sichelukhanya High School as well as Zama High School, from KwaZulu-Natal.
