SUBJECT: NATIONAL SCHOOL NUTRITION PROGRAMME CALL FOR SCHOOLS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF BASIC EDUCATION RECYCLED ART COMPETITION IN COMMEMORATION OF THE WORLD SCHOOL MILK DAY 2022.

- 1. The National School Nutrition Programme (NSNP) aims to enhance learning capacity and improve access to education by providing nutritious meals to learners in targeted public ordinary schools and identified special schools.
- 2. The World School Milk Day (WSMD) is an approved activity in the NSNP Business Plan 2022/23 and will be commemorated on the 29th of September as it is done every year, in order to address the important role that dairy plays in the lives of school going children. The objective is to create awareness and inform school communities of how dairy meets the nutritional needs of children.
- 3. The overarching objective with the WSMD 2022 campaign will be celebrated under the theme "Dairy gives you GO for a healthy me and environment"! which will focus and showcase how dairy makes a difference in the health status of the school communities (learners, educators, Volunteer Food Handlers, School Governing Bodies and general workers).
- 4. The learners will be sensitized to the importance of looking after their health and the health of the school environment by using the packaging of dairy products to make artwork instead of just discarding the packaging.
- 5. The aim is also to teach children about recycling, by improving their recycling habits, they can help keep the environment clean and preserve the natural resources, while showcasing artistic talent.
- 6. Educators to use the nutritional message of the CEP in contact session to inform learners about the importance of dairy. Then issue the challenge, to create art works from recycled dairy packaging material in small groups (3-5 learners per group).
 - This WSMD 2022 school-based activity competition targets all primary schools (Quintile 1-5) and special schools

- Educators are requested to assist in selecting the participating learners and group them according to their grades.
- Educators are requested to guide the selected groups to create artistic pieces from recycled dairy packaging materials (N.B.: Only learners are expected to do the work)
- Participating learners will have to collect empty dairy/milk sachet, plastic containers, cups, bottle or bags and upcycle them into a piece of art.
- Learners must be innovative and creative.
- Arts and Culture educators can assist the learners with the project.
- The art pieces that will be created can be 2 or 3 dimensional.
- 7. Entrants are expected to compete under three following categories / divisions:
 - Gr R to 2 Dairy animals (cows, sheep, goats)
 - Gr 3 to 4 Self or landscape portraits (collage and/or mosaic)
 - Gr 5 to 7 Fashion and/or accessories e.g. dress, school uniform, shoes, general clothing, jewellery, bags etc.
- 8. The attached entry forms must be filled in correctly and in detail with as much information as possible to assist the evaluation process. Nomination not meeting the criteria will be disqualified.
- 9. The schools will select and nominate the best art pieces per grade.
- 10. Completed entry/nomination forms attached to nominated art work/piece per category division or evidence/supporting material i.e. photos, DVD/USB must be delivered to your nearest district/ circuit/ area office of the District Department of Education on 11 October 2022.
- 11. The District will select one best art piece per grade and submit all selected entries to Provincial Education Department on 25 October 2022.

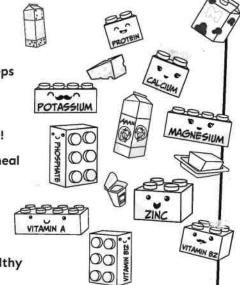
Did you know that

- Vitamin B12 an important vitamin to keep your brain healthy and help you think smart



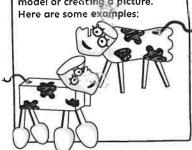

Get your friends together and enter as groups of three to five in the following categories:



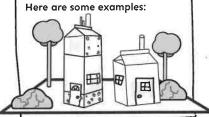
