TERM TWO REVISED ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES 4 – 9 AND COMMON TESTING FOR GRADES 10 -12

- 1. The above matter refers.
- 2. Attached herewith is the revised 2025 common test timetable for Grades 10 -12 (ANNEXURE A).
- All schools that obtained an overall pass percentage of 85% and below in the 2024 NSC examination must adhere to the revised common test programme.
- 4. Schools that obtained above 85% in the 2024 NSC examination, who have voluntarily requested to participate in the common test must also adhere to the revised common test programme.
- 5. Grade 12 common tests will be conducted from **18**th **June to 29**th **July 2025** as per the revised timetable.
- 6. Grade 12 marks must be submitted to District Examinations by **15**th **August 2025** to enable planning for targeted interventions.
- 7. Grades 10 and 11 common tests will be conducted from 18th June to 29th July 2025.
- 8. Grades 4 9 must conduct their internal mid-year examinations from **28**th **July to 08**th **August 2025**.
- 9. Marking for Grades 4 11 must be concluded by **15**th **August 2025** and schools must immediately issue report cards to learners.

TERM TWO REVISED ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES 4 – 9 AND COMMON TESTING FOR GRADES 10 -12

- 10. Schools must also ensure that marks are captures and uploaded to SASAMS by 15th August 2025.
- 11. Schools that have been able to conduct their mid-year assessments are NOT expected to adhere to this revised assessment programme.
