The Head of Department of Education in KwaZulu-Natal, Mr Nkosinathi Ngcobo will address the alumni of KwaMgaga High School as they honour their former Principal, Mr Vuma Mfeka who has served the school with distinction.

KwaMgaga High School has a very rich history and is well known for having produced prominent community leaders and public figures who are playing critical & leading roles in society to date.

Mr Mfeka, a former principal at KwaMgaga High School, was very influential during the days of the liberation struggle. His journey as a teacher dates back in 1984 in uMlazi Township, a period characterized by student protests against Bantu Education.

Despite widespread students' protests and other progressive forces, Mr Mfeka often set aside time and ensured that his students acquire decent education. This event is significant because it takes place on the eve of June 16, Youth Day, a well celebrated public holiday in South Africa in Honour of Youths who also fought against the oppressive Bantu Education.
