HOD NATHI NGCOBO ON THE LAST LEG OF THE DISTRICT SUPPORT VISITS

The Head of Department, Mr Nkosinathi Ngcobo together with the Members of Top Management, began the programme of District Support Visits on 31st of May 2023, which started at Ugu District.

The purpose of the visits is to monitor the progress in the implementation of the Academic improvement plan as well as to offer support to districts, circuits and schools.

Districts Extended Manco, Subject Advisors and principals of schools with large enrolment that attained below 75%; and those schools that performed below 40% in the 2022 NSC results, formed part of the districts delegation to present before the top management of the Department.

As part of these support visits, District Directors are expected to prepare presentations on interventions following the term one results analysis, general state of readiness and plans regarding winter and spring vacation classes.

Having visited all the 10 Districts of the Department, on Thursday, 22 June 2023, the HOD is going to be on the last leg of the Districts Support Visits, which will see uMlazi and Pinetown Districts presenting their case before the Top Management.
