OFFICIAL LAUNCH OF SOCIAL COHESION IN PHOENIX

PMB - The Department of Education in KwaZulu-Natal will launch a Social Cohesion programme through Sports, Arts and a Cultural Festival, which will be presided over by the Premier of KwaZulu-Natal, Mr Sihle Zikalala, MEC for Education, Mr Kwazi Mshengu, and other Members of the Executive.

On the day of the event, learners are going to participate in various sporting activities, cultural activities as well as oral debates on various topics relating to social cohesion.
