THE DEPARTMENT COMMENCES WITH THE MARKING PROCESS

The Department of Education in KwaZulu-Natal is ready for the marking of the 2023 National Senior Certificate Examinations.

The marking process will commence on 09 December 2023 and concludes on 20 December 2023.

There are 32 marking centres in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. The Province has a total of 8 738 personnel involved in the marking process, which comprises of 6 926 markers, 1 381 Senior Markers, 277 Deputy Chief Markers, 67 Chief Markers and 87 Moderators.

The training of marking personnel will begin on 06 December and concludes on 09 December 2023.

“We want to encourage markers to take this process of marking with all the seriousness and diligence it deserves. We urge them to deal with each and every script with the understanding that they are dealing with the learner’s future, hence we impress upon them to be very thorough while marking the learner’s scripts,” said MEC Mbali Frazer.
