MEC FRAZER INTRODUCE CONTRACTOR FOR FENCING AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO SCHOOLS IN RURAL NDESHENI

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Education, Ms Mbali Frazer, today introduced to INkosi Dube and the community of Ndesheni, a contractor who will be fencing Ndesheni High and Gubhethuka Primary schools in King Cetshwayo District.

This comes after INkosi Dube requested urgent intervention from MEC Frazer to have the two schools fenced to ensure safety of learners and educators. Ndesheni area is reported to have a high rate of crime with several incidents having been previously reported at the schools.

“The contractor will be here on Tuesday 26 September 2023 to start this project of fencing the two schools. They will also ensure that local people especially emerging contractors and those seeking job opportunities are able to benefit from this project”, said MEC Frazer.

MEC Frazer further made a commitment to send professional teams to do renovations and general maintenance to give Ndesheni High a much needed facelift.

INkosi Dube expressed his gratitude for the swift response by MEC Frazer following his request for her intervention.
