MEC FOR EDUCATION TO HANDOVER MOBILE CLASSROOMS

The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Education, Mr Sipho Hlomuka, will on the 10th of October 2024 hand over mobile classrooms donated to the Department by Eskom and the implementing Agent, Red Cross, to Ngibongeleni High School, Sizathina High School, and Inhlonhlweni High School, all under uThukela District.

The MEC for Education, together with departmental social partners, seeks to temporarily bring relief and support to schools amid the process of refurbishing dilapidated school infrastructure.

The mobile classrooms come as a generous and essential aid to victims of storm damage. They provide temporary yet reliable educational infrastructure pending permanent structure renovations, and for that, we remain eternally grateful to both Red Cross and Eskom.

"The total number of mobile classrooms to be handed over is 26, divided amongst 3 schools under uThukela. The donation comes at an opportune time when our learners will soon sit for the 2024 year-end examinations, which ought to be administered successfully."

"As the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Education, we want the paucity of safe and secure school infrastructure to be a thing of the past," said MEC Hlomuka.
