The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Education, Mr Sipho Hlomuka, has extended heartfelt sympathy to the committed National Senior Certificate (NSC) marking personnel whose vehicles were damaged during the severe hailstorm that impacted Pholela Special School and surrounding areas over the past two days.

The unexpected and extreme weather conditions resulted in extensive damage, including shattered windscreens, dented bodywork, and other significant impairments to several vehicles. Despite this distressing incident, the markers continued to carry out their duties with remarkable professionalism, ensuring that the integrity, timelines and overall progress of the NSC marking process remained uninterrupted. MEC Hlomuka expressed deep concern over the ordeal experienced by the affected personnel.

The Department remains steadfast in its commitment to ensuring that the marking process proceeds seamlessly, with the welfare of our educators remaining paramount," he added.
